
THE PHARISEE AND THE PUBLICAN (LUKE CHAPTER 18)

Jesus told a type of story known as a parable for those that **trusted** in themselves to get to heaven and did not think much of other people: Two men went up to the **temple** to **pray**. One was a very religious man known as a **Pharisee** and the other was a **tax** collector. Tax collectors weren't liked among the Jews. When the Pharisee prayed, the Lord Jesus said that he "prayed... with **himself**." He thanked God that he wasn't like other people, including the tax collector. The tax collector could not even so much as look upwards to heaven because he was so ashamed of who he was. Instead he bowed his head and asked for God's **mercy**, saying that he was a **sinner**. Jesus said that the tax collector went home **right** with **God** and not the Pharisee.
